Throughout the planning, construction, and operational phases of this great endeavor God has mandated for FCCC, Dr. Moore has stressed that the purpose of The Bridge is 3fold. The first role of this facility is to assist in meeting physical and social needs of our members and whom serve. Secondly, it provides opportunity for us to minister to those in our community, and finally, it is to be used as tool of economic evangelism to the world.

Even before the doors of The Bridge were opened, that 3fold purpose had begun to manifest in many different ways. Although the facility is not fully complete, we've been able to open The FitZone, host a Men's Fight Bowling Night, numerous Events, provide a Disaster Relief Distribution Center, Red other Shelter and Cross services to the community, provide classroom playground space for the Children's Ministry, house a full summer camp, supply office space for displaced FCCC employees, host a Women's Expo, serve as a Dance Studio. and more! Even this list sounds though impressive, there are still countless possibilities for what The Bridge can offer.

however, is not how much we can do, but the lives that are We've touched. had numerous testimonies from people who have made decisions to return to church, simply because of how impressed they have been with the facility, the kindness the people atmosphere of peace in it.
